

WARDEN TRAINING



The course is developed for members appointed to the facilities Emergency Control Organisation or Warden team. It covers the initial hazard identification, pre-planning and preparation for Wardens of their areas of responsibility including the development of particular plans to provide assistance to those occupants that may require it.

It also covers the facilities emergency response systems and their operation, the roles and responsibilities of a Warden in the event of an emergency and related human behaviours that they may experience during an incident.

These units will also form a solid foundation for those who will be undertaking the role of Chief Warden in their facility.

Successfully completing this nationally recognised training will result in a Statement of Attainment being awarded for:

- PUAFER001 – Identify, prevent and report potential facility emergency situations
- PUAFER004 – Respond to facility emergencies
- PUAFER005 – Operate as part of an Emergency Control Organisation (ECO)
- PUAFER008 – Confine small emergencies in a facility
- PUAFER009 – Participate as a member of a facility emergency response team
